Notes:

1. Membership is on a January 1 to December 31 basis.
2. Pennsylvania Chapter Contractor members are automatically members of ACPA NATIONAL. Volume based assessments of \$0.55/\$1,000 will be collected by the Chapter and forwarded to ACPA NATIONAL.
3. Base dues are payable at the beginning of each year and are prorated on a quarterly basis. That is, if a company joins in the 3rd quarter of given year, they owe dues for the 3rd and 4th quarter of that year. Companies joining the Pennsylvania Chapter in December, and paying base dues in full, will have those dues applied to the following year, but their membership will begin immediately (i.e. dues will not be prorated for the 4th quarter).
4. New members will not be assessed for any work on any project awarded prior to joining the Chapter, unless extraordinary assistance for a project by the Chapter is deemed necessary and appropriate by the Member. Assessments will be billed at the end of each quarter and will be based on bid-tab results.
5. Assessable items in the highway, airport, and street & local road markets are as follows:
 - a. CONCRETE PAVING: Concrete pavement, Concrete shoulders, Concrete overlays, Roller compacted concrete, Concrete cores, Saw cutting pavement joints, Joint assemblies, Longitudinal/transverse joint sealing, Joint sealant materials, Expansion joints, Bridge approach slabs on concrete jobs, and Reinforcing steel for concrete slabs. Effective with project awarded on/after January 1, 2010: Precast concrete panels.
 - b. CONCRETE PAVEMENT RESTORATION: Full-depth patching, Partial-depth patching, Dowel bar retrofit, Tie bar retrofit, Diamond-grinding, Diamond-grooving, Joint/crack sawing/resealing, and Slab stabilization.
 - c. CEMENT TREATED STABILIZED BASES: Soil cement, Econocrete/lean concrete, Cement treated permeable base, and Cement treated recycled materials
 - d. ANCILLARY PAVING: Concrete median/traffic barrier, and Concrete curb & gutter.
 - e. MOBILIZATION: Effective with projects advertised on/after January 1, 2010, the percent of mobilization attributed to assessable work compared with the contract amount will no longer be an assessable item.
6. Payment for assessable work is as follows:
 - a. If both the prime and subcontractor are members, the prime contractor pays assessments for the work that they do, and the subcontractors pays assessments for the work that they do.
 - b. If a prime is a member and has a non-member subcontractor performing assessable work, the prime contractor is responsible for payment on the assessable work.
 - c. If the prime is a non-member, the subcontractor is responsible for any assessable work that they do.
7. Projects awarded prior to January 1, 2008 will be assessed at a rate of \$3.20/\$1,000 on assessable work. Projects awarded between January 1, 2008 and December 31, 2011 will be assessed at a rate of \$2.35/\$1,000 on assessable work. Work will be invoiced at time of award, with payment due quarterly as work is completed.
