Because our staff interacts with PENNDOT and other agency personnel in the Commonwealth on a daily basis, we become your personal avenue to decision makers on pavement issues.

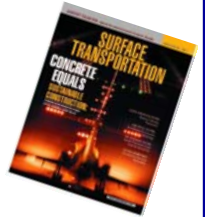
Continuous Promotion
